New Life for Youth's blend of services, training for self sufficiency and peer support have proven to be effective in helping the women re-enter society for over 20 years. Over eighty percent of the women who have completed the program are drug free and living a productive, self-supporting life. Over the years, literally hundreds of women have completed the program and returned to the community as fit parents and productive citizens.

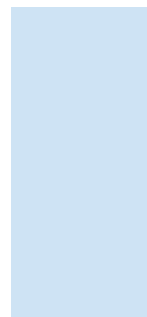
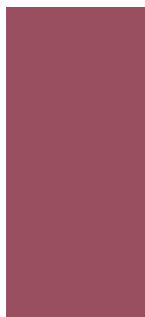
An outreach program by New Life for Youth designed to give mothers a chance to enter a rehabilitative program without being separated from their children.

NEW LIFE FOR YOUTH - OPERATES A HOME FOR WOMEN AND WOMEN WITH CHILDREN CALLED "MOTHER'S ON THE MOVE" a Christian non-profit, non-denominational, crisis intervention facility for single women and women with children. It is one of the few long-term voluntary programs - the only program in the region - that accepts women with their children, even accepting addicts who are pregnant.

Virtually all of the mothers who seek out the M.O.M. program, do so because they wish to enter a rehabilitative program without separating from their children. The program occupies 6.1 acres of land in Concord, North Carolina.

## THE PROGRAM

Women who come into the program are usually trapped in a tragic cycle of homelessness, poverty, abuse and substance addiction. They often are not willing to enter treatment at the expense of separating from their children.

In most cases, drug and/or alcohol use is just one of the women's problems, and to focus exclusively on the individual's substance abuse without dealing with other aspects of the person's life, is like treating the symptoms without regard to the possible cause.

Our method of treatment is to deal with the individual's whole being; body, soul and spirit. New Life approaches man as a three part being, and emphasizes a life changing relationship with Jesus Christ as described in 2 Corinthians 5:17. It is the most beautiful thing to see a broken, drug addicted woman come to a saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ, and watch God transform her by His Spirit!
